It shows us two things, they are faithful to their Savior and they are accepting his leadership. This is a great step in preparing him to take over the pastorate."

Marcio and Neide invited a couple to visit the church; the new couple is attending regularly on Sunday and Wednesday services. The couple has many questions as did Marcio and Neide. Our desire is to see them trust Christ, before our return to Brazil next month.

The church in Caruaru is sponsoring a spiritual retreat during the Easter weekend. We should have people come from several churches even in adjoining cities. All of the planning is being done by the people in Caruaru – this is another step in their "independence" from the missionary – me! I just adore seeing the church taking these positive steps.

Please be in prayer for a young couple trying to resurrect a problem mission we have helped. He was really discouraged this morning when I talked with him. He is a young man that has not completed his studies and was thrown into a hornet's nest. We have and will continue to give him encouragement and a place of refuge if the work fails.

Several have contributed to the need for a vehicle to reach the interior. We still need to raise a considerable sum for the vehicle. We will also need a library (please no English books) and material for each of the Bible Institutes that we will start.

Please be in prayer for a young man, Romualdo, who is teaching music to one of our teenagers. He has asked me to go to the city where he lives and start a church. He is a tremendous musician, but without a church. We need men to accept the call of God to go and preach the Word to the uttermost. Will you consider the call?
