We continue to need your prayers as we pursue the ministry of chaplain in the local jail, as there have been some roadblocks and we still don't have the go ahead. I met with the sheriff who has the final say-so, and he seemed very positive, and was supposed to get back with me in a short while. When I didn't hear from him, I contacted them again, and found he was in the hospital and not able to work. He is now back in the office, but although I have been by there a couple of times, so far has not gotten back to me, and we have not been able to do anything else concerning this.

We are helping at the mission with an mailing outreach, and are praying that we will see results from that. The Bible Institute lost it's most faithful students, a man and wife, who have been attending since the beginning. He fell ill with the cold and flu that was going around first, and then during a hard coughing fit, something happened that cause his right side to be affected. It had the appearance of a stroke, so he went to the doctor, and so far all they have told him is that he has a nodule on his brain stem. He had to get an appointment with a doctor in Little Rock, and it has taken him two months to be able to get in there. His name is James Jarret. Please pray for him, and his health.

We attended a mission conference at Bible Baptist Church in Nevada, Missouri, and were really blessed during our time with them. We appreciate this church and their faithful support of the ministry throughout the years.
