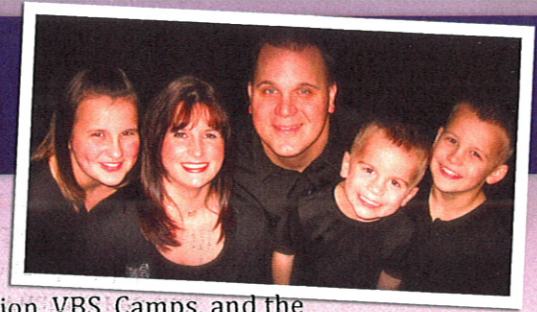


# WATSON FAMILY

Today is the first day I've been home and I'm still recovering. A long with all of this, Kendra's Grandfather passed away on July 4th. Through all these difficulties, we've done our best to continue with the Lord's work. I have missed almost an entire month of work due to church camp and my health issues. What makes that increasingly difficult is that with my job it is also commissioned based with base pay, so missing working costs us double. I do have insurance but the medical bills are still piling up. I know that the Lord will meet our needs, but I would ask you if nothing else, to pray for us as we try to recover from these difficulties physically and financially. We had planned to have a public launch service on July 31<sup>st</sup> but we must postpone it because of my health issues. My heart felt thanks to Mosaic Baptist Church (Raleigh Campbell Jr. - Pastor) for your love offering for the launch service. What a blessing you are to the Lord's work here in San Marcos. We are looking forward to rescheduling the service, and use it to watch the Lord receive glory and watch Satan squirm. We would ask your support and prayers during these difficult times.

We know the Lord has great things ahead for New Life Baptist Mission and it's been so wonderful to have even a small taste of the things to come. Thank you to all who are supporting this wonderful ministry.
